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CHAPTER 11.

FOREIGN TRIBUNAL (CITATION).

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TO PROVIDE FOR SERVICE OF PROCESS OR CITATION IN
CYPRUS IN RELATION TO CIVIL OR COMMERCIAL
MATTERS PENDING BEFORE COURTS AND TRIBUNALS
OTHER THAN THOSE OF CYPRUS.

1. This Law may be cited as the Foreign Tribunal Citation Law. Short title.

2. In this Law—

“foreign country” shall mean and include any country other than Cyprus, and “foreign” shall mean of or belonging to such country.

Interpreta-
tion.

3. Where in any civil or commercial matter pending before a Court or Tribunal of a foreign country, a Commission Rogatoire or Letter of Request from such Court or Tribunal for service on any person in Cyprus of any process or citation in such matter is transmitted to the Supreme Court by Her Majesty's Secretary of State for the Colonies with an intimation that it is desirable that effect should be given to the same, the following procedure shall be adopted:—

(a) the Letter of Request for service shall be accompanied by a translation thereof in the English language, and by two copies of the process or
