CHAPTER 14.

LIMITATION (ENEMIES AND WAR PRISONERS).

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS.

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A LAW TO PROVIDE FOR SUSPENDING THE OPERATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS REGARDING LIMITATION OF ACTIONS IN RELATION TO PROCEEDINGS AFFECTING PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN ENEMIES OR HAVE BEEN DETAINED IN ENEMY TERRITORY.

1. This Law may be cited as the Limitation (Enemies and War Prisoners) Law. Short title.

2. (1) In this Law—

“action” means civil proceedings before any Court or tribunal, and includes arbitration proceedings ;

“enemy” means any person who is, or is deemed to be, an enemy for any of the purposes of the Trading with the Enemy Law, except that in ascertaining whether a person is such an enemy the expression “enemy territory” in section 4 of the said Law shall have the meaning assigned to that expression by this section ;

“enemy territory” means any area which is enemy territory as defined by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Trading with the Enemy Law and also any area in relation to which the provisions of the said Law apply by virtue of an Order made by the Governor directing such area to be treated for the purposes of the said Law as enemy territory ;

“statute of limitation” means any Law in force in the Colony at the date of the coming into operation of this Law under which a period is prescribed as the
