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CHAPTER 82.

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TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE PROTECTION
OF CERTAIN RIVERS.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Rivers Protection Law.

Interpreta-
tion.

2. In this Law—

“bank or wall of any river” means the land on each side of a bed of any river, to a distance of six feet therefrom;

“bed of any river” means the whole of the lands between the extreme limits of the water way formed by any river, including all banks, eyots or islands within such limits, except such as are under cultivation;

“Commissioner” means the Commissioner of the district in which the river or portion of the river is situate;

“river” means a public river or any portion of a public river declared by Order of the Governor in Council to be a river under this Law.

3. The Governor in Council may by Order to be published in the Gazette declare any public river or any portion of a public river to be a river for the purposes of this Law, and from and after the date of the publication of such Order this Law shall be in full force and effect in respect of the river or portion of the river to which the Order refers.
