Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Salt Law.

Property and
control of
salt vested

2. The entire property in and control of all salt naturally formed within any part of the Colony is and shall be vested in the Government of Cyprus.

3. (1) No person shall collect any salt naturally formed, or manufacture salt by any process whatsoever within any part of the Colony except with the written permission of the Comptroller previously obtained.

(2) Any person acting in contravention of subsection (1) hereof shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to imprisonment not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding five pounds or to both such imprisonment and fine and in addition thereto he shall pay a sum at the rate of twenty-five mils for every oke of salt so collected or manufactured.

4. Any person who takes any salt from any salt pan, salt lake, salt heap or place in which salt is collected or kept on behalf of the Government of Cyprus shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to imprisonment
