DOCUMENTS (SPECIAL DUTY).

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A LAW TO IMPOSE A SPECIAL DUTY IN RESPECT OF CERTAIN DOCUMENTS.

Short title.

[2nd November, 1944.]

1. This Law may be cited as the Documents (Special Duty) Law.

Interpre-
tation.

2. In this Law—

“appropriate authority” means the authority established by, or appointed under, or mentioned in, any Law or public instrument enumerated in column 2 of the Schedule hereto, having power to deal with any document described in column 3 of the Schedule hereto.

Schedule.

Special duty

3. Whenever any document described in column 3 of the Schedule hereto:—

Schedule.

(a) is made or delivered; or

(b) is issued by the appropriate authority; or

(c) is sent to or left with the appropriate authority,

under the provisions of any Law or public instrument enumerated in column 2 of the Schedule hereto, there shall be paid to the appropriate authority, in respect of every such document, a special duty at the rate appearing in column 4 of the said Schedule and set opposite to the description of such document.

Special duty
to be paid
by adhesive
stamps.

4. The special duty imposed by this Law shall be paid by adhesive stamps of a value equal to the rate appearing in column 4 of the Schedule hereto, and such adhesive stamps shall be affixed as follows, that is to say—

(a) where the document is issued by the appropriate
