TO PRESERVE THE APPLICABILITY OF CERTAIN
STATUTE LAWS.

WHEREAS by virtue of the Cyprus (Annexation) Order in Council, 1914, Cyprus was annexed to His Majesty's Dominions.

And whereas by virtue of the said Order in Council the greater part of those persons in Cyprus who before the coming into operation of the said Order were Ottoman subjects have become British subjects.

And whereas it is expedient that the provisions of the laws hereinafter referred to should remain applicable in the same manner as before the date of the said Order in Council.

Be it therefore enacted:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Statute Laws Application Law, 1915.
