3. It shall be lawful for the High Commissioner to cause to be issued and paid for the purposes aforesaid any sum not exceeding in the whole the sums in that behalf herein before specified.

TO AMEND THE PROVISIONAL POWERS LAWS.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Provisional Powers (Amendment) Law, 1924, and shall be read as one with the Provisional Powers Laws, 1919 to 1921, and the said Laws and this Law may together be cited as the Provisional Powers Laws, 1919 to 1924.

Amendment of Law 12 of 1919.

2. The Provisional Powers Law, 1919, is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following section:—

4. During the period of five years from the date of the determination of the present war, as declared in section 2, the High Commissioner in Council, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other law, may make orders:—

(1) To regulate dealing with coinage and currency notes and provide for the issue of currency notes.

(2) To provide for the custody by a Public Custodian of property belonging to any person who either during or at the date of the conclusion of the present war was an enemy or the subject of an enemy State as defined by any Proclamation or Order in reference thereto, and for the disposal thereof.

Repeal of Law 12 of 1919, section 4, paragraph (2).

3. The Provisional Powers Law, 1919, section 4, paragraph (2), is hereby repealed.

Repeal of Law 39 of 1923.

4. The Provisional Powers (Amendment) Law, 1923, is hereby repealed.

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
