1. This Law may be cited as the British Nationality and Status of Aliens (Fees) Law, 1924. Short title.

2. The High Commissioner in Council may make Regulations providing for the imposition of fees in respect of any registration authorised to be made by the British Nationality and Status of Aliens Acts, 1914 to 1922, and in respect of the making of any declaration or the grant of any certificate authorised to be made or granted by the said Acts, and in respect of the administration or registration of any oath: Provided that in the case of a woman who was a British subject previously to her marriage to an alien, and whose husband has died or whose marriage has been dissolved, the fee for the grant of a certificate shall not exceed five shillings. Power to make Regulations imposing fees.

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
