WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for certain expenses of the Government of Cyprus, which are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law.

BE it therefore enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Surplus Balance Appropriation Law, 1926. Short title.

2. There shall be issued and applied during the period of twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1926, to the services enumerated hereunder an additional sum not exceeding the sum of fifty-one thousand pounds for defraying the services herein declared. The said amount shall be appropriated as follows:—
