BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Former Enemy Aliens Short title.
(Disabilities Removal) Law, 1926.

2. The enactments mentioned in the Schedule to this Law which impose disabilities on subjects, citizens, and companies of former enemy aliens shall as from the commencement of this Law be repealed.

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Advocates (Amendment) Short title.
Law, 1926, and shall be read as one with the Advocates
Law, 1894, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law),
and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited
as the Advocates Laws, 1894 and 1926.

2. The Principal Law, Section 4 (3) is hereby amended
by the addition after the word "diploma" of the words
"otherwise than by correspondence" and by the addition
after the word "Denmark" of the following proviso:—
