

Provided always, that no co-surety, co-contractor, or co-debtor shall be entitled to recover from any other co-surety, co-contractor, or co-debtor, by the means aforesaid, more than the just proportion to which, as between those parties themselves, such last mentioned person shall be justly liable.

Power to
make Rules
of Court.

3. The Governor, with the advice and assistance of the Chief Justice, may from time to time by writing under the hand and official seal of the Governor and the hand of the Chief Justice make Rules of Court for the better execution of the provisions of this Law.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make additional provision for the service for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1925.

BE it therefore enacted:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Law, 1926.

Appropriation of £8,911 for twelve months ended 31st December, 1925.

2. There shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ended the thirty-first day of December, 1925, an additional sum not exceeding the sum of eight thousand nine hundred and eleven pounds for defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for such period. The said amount shall be appropriated as follows:—
