BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Delegation of Powers Short title.
Law, 1927.

2. The Governor may from time to time by writing under his hand depute to the Colonial Secretary or other person or persons designated in such writing all or any one or more of the powers and authorities vested in him under or by virtue of the provisions of the Laws set out in the Schedule hereto.

Governor may delegate the powers vested in him by provisions of Laws mentioned in Schedule hereto.
