BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Municipal Councils (Amendment) Law, 1927, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Councils Law, 1882, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law), and the Municipal Councils (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1926. Short title.

2. The Principal Law, section 30 (1), as amended by the Municipal Councils (Amendment, No. 2) Law, 1926, section 8, is hereby amended by the deletion in line 2 of the word “and” and the substitution therefor of the word “or.” Amendment of Law 6 of 1882, sec. 30 (1), as amended by Law 28 of 1926, sec. 8.

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Amendment) Law, 1927, and shall be read as one with the Wireless Telegraphy Law, 1913, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy Laws, 1913 and 1927. Short title.

2. The expression “transmission” where used in section 2 and section 6 of the Principal Law relating to messages includes, and shall be deemed always to have included, the reception as well as the sending of messages. Explanation of expression “transmission” in section 2 and section 6 of Law 9 of 1913.
