WHEREAS it is necessary to make additional provision for the service for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1927.

BE it therefore enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Short title.
Appropriation Law, 1928.

2. There shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ended the thirty-first day of December, 1927, an additional sum not exceeding the sum of eight thousand five hundred and thirty-six pounds for defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for such period. The said amount shall be appropriated as follows:—
