TO AMEND THE PROVISIONAL POWERS LAWS.

BE it enacted:--

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Provisional Powers (Amendment) Law, 1928, and shall be read as one with the Provisional Powers Laws, 1919 to 1926, and the said Laws and this Law may together be cited as the Provisional Powers Laws, 1919 to 1928.

Amendment
of Law 12 of

2. The Provisional Powers Law, 1919, is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following section:—

Power to
Governor in
Council.

4. During the period of nine years from the date of the determination of the present war, as declared by section 2, the Governor in Council, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other Law, may make orders:—

(1) To regulate, permit or prohibit the exportation and importation of animals and things.

(2) To regulate dealing with coinage and currency notes and provide for the issue of currency notes.

(3) To provide for the custody by a Public Custodian of property belonging to any person who either during or at the date of the conclusion of the present war was an enemy or the subject of an enemy State as defined by any Proclamation or Order in reference thereto, and for the disposal thereof.

3. The Provisional Powers (Amendment) Law, 1926, is hereby repealed.
