TO AMEND THE POLICE LAW.

BE it enacted :—

Short title,

1. This Law may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Law, 1929, and shall be read as one with the Police Law, 1878, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law), and the Police (Amendment) Law, 1927, and the Police (Amendment) Law, 1928, and the Principal Law and the said Laws and this Law may together be cited as the Police Laws, 1878 to 1929.

2. The Principal Law, section 22, is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the words “or of summary dismissal from the force for any cause” after the words “or of reduction of grade.”.

3. The Principal Law, section 43, is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “Rural Police Fund” means the Rural Police Fund established under the provisions of this Law.”.

4. The Principal Law, section 48, is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “into the Rural Police Fund” in lines seven and eight and the substitution therefor of the words “into the Revenues of Cyprus.”

5. The Principal Law, section 54, is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “out of the Rural Police Fund” in lines one and two and the substitution therefor of the words “out of the Revenues of Cyprus.”

6. The Principal Law, section 55, is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “out of the Rural Police Fund” in line three and the substitution therefor of the words “out of the Revenues of Cyprus.”

7. The Principal Law, section 59, is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “from the Rural Police Fund” in lines five and six and the substitution therefor of the words “from the Revenues of Cyprus.”

8. The Principal Law, section 60 (b), is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “to the Rural Police Fund” in line two and the substitution therefor of the words “into the Revenues of Cyprus.”
