A.D. 1932. A LAW TO AMEND THE NEWSPAPER, BOOKS AND PRINTING
32 of 1932. PRESSES LAW, 1930.

BE it enacted:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Newspaper, Books and Printing Presses (Amendment) Law, 1932, and shall be read as one with the Newspaper, Books and Printing Presses Law, 1930, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Newspaper, Books and Printing Presses Laws, 1930 and 1932.

Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Law.

2. The definition of "Newspaper" in section 2 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "and published in Cyprus periodically or in parts or numbers".

Amendment of section 12 (1) of the Principal Law.

3. Section 12 (1) of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "every" in line 1 and by the substitution therefor of the word "every".

Amendment of section 15 (1) of the Principal Law.

4. Section 15 (1) of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "signed by the proprietor" immediately after the word "thereto" in line 5.

Repeal of section 17 of the Principal Law and substitution of new section.

5. Section 17 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:—

" 17.—(1) The proprietor shall publish free of charge not later than in the second issue of his newspaper after receipt thereof :

(a) any statement under the hand of the Governor or of the Colonial Secretary on his behalf relating to matters of public policy or general interest ;

(b) a correction without additions or omissions of any statement of fact published in such newspaper if requested so to do by the Colonial Secretary. Any such correction shall be given the same prominence as the original statement.
