A LAW TO AMEND THE FLAGS (PROHIBITION) LAW, 1931. A.D. 1932.

*Officer Administering the Government.*

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Flags Prohibition (Amendment) Law, 1932, and shall be read as one with the Flags (Prohibition) Law, 1931, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Flags (Prohibition) Laws, 1931 and 1932.

Short title.

2. The proviso to section 2 of the Principal Law shall be deleted and the following proviso shall be substituted therefor:—

"Provided that this Law shall not apply to flags, banners, streamers or pennants which:—

(1) are flown—

(a) by His Majesty's Naval, Military or Air Forces;  
or

(b) by any duly accredited Consul or Consular Agent; or

(c) on any ship, boat or aircraft in accordance with the provisions of any Act of the Imperial Parliament or of any Cyprus Law or of any rule or regulation made respectively thereunder; or

(d) on any ship, boat or aircraft in accordance with the requirements of the International Code of Signals or as house flags or signal flags or quarantine flags; or

(e) on any foreign ship, boat or aircraft in order to indicate the nationality of such ship, boat or aircraft; or

(f) on any ship, boat or aircraft of the Naval or Air Forces of any foreign State; or

(2) are authorized by the Governor to be flown."

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
