A LAW TO AMEND THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY
TAX LAW, 1932.

BE it enacted :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Immovable Property Tax (Amendment) Law, 1934, and shall be read as one with the Immovable Property Tax Law, 1932, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Immovable Property Tax Laws, 1932 and 1934.

2. The Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after section 5 of the following section :—

"Power to
Governor
to increase
Immovable
Property
Tax.

5A. The Governor in Council may by Order to be published in the *Cyprus Gazette* direct that the rate of Immovable Property Tax payable in respect of immovable property owned by any one person within the limits of any village or quarter of any village shall be increased in any year by such percentage not exceeding one per thousand on the capital value of such immovable property as assessed in accordance with the provisions of this Law, as may be directed in such Order and any such increase shall be collected and paid in the same manner and at the same time as the Immovable Property Tax payable thereon."

This Law came into operation on 12th March, 1934.
