A LAW TO AMEND THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS
LAWS, 1930 AND 1935.

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Tree Planting Village Areas (Amendment) Law, 1936, and shall be read as one with the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 and 1935, (hereinafter called “the Principal Law”), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 18 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

Amendment

“(1) If, after the commencement of any plantation on any land in any Tree Planting Area, any animal is grazed, driven, led or taken, whether by the owner or any other person in, upon, through or along any such area, the owner of such animal (unless he proves to the satisfaction of the Court that the trespass was committed without his knowledge or consent) and the person in whose charge it was at the time of such grazing, driving, leading or taking; or”

This Law came into operation on 10th January, 1936,
