A LAW TO AMEND THE SECONDARY EDUCATION LAW, 1935.

BE it enacted :—

Short title.

25 of 1935.

1. This Law may be cited as the Secondary Education (Amendment) Law, 1936, and shall be read as one with the Secondary Education Law, 1935, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Secondary Education Laws, 1935 and 1936.

2. Section 9 (1) of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion of the following as paragraph (b), the subsequent paragraphs being re-numbered accordingly :—

"(b) the financial resources of the governing body ;"

3. Section 29 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

"Accounts
of certain
governing
bodies to be
audited.

29.—(1) The accounts of every governing body to which section 23 or 24 applies shall be made up to the 15th day of July in every year and shall, within twenty-one days from that date, be—

(a) closed ;

(b) examined and verified by the governing body ;

(c) signed by at least three members of the governing body ;

(d) submitted, together with all vouchers, records and documents relating thereto, by the governing body to two auditors for audit.

(2) The auditors shall be appointed by the governing body and shall receive such remuneration as the governing body may fix.

(3) Every appointment of an auditor and his remuneration shall be subject to the approval of the Director and shall not take effect until approved by him.
