BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs and Excise Regulation (Amendment) Law, 1936, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise Regulation Laws, 1879 to (No. 3) 1930, (hereinafter called “the Principal Law”), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Customs and Excise Regulation Laws, 1879 to 1936.

2. Section 63 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

“ Power to
prohibit
exportation.

63. The Governor may by Order in Council to be published in the Gazette—

(a) prohibit the exportation of any goods or animals;

(b) place restrictions or impose conditions on the exportation of any goods or animals.”

Amendment
of section 64
of Law 24
of 1879.

3. Section 64 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “or any animals in contravention of any Order” and by the substitution therefor of the words “or any goods or animals in contravention of any Order in Council”.

This Law came into operation on 31st March, 1936.
