A LAW TO AMEND THE LAW REGULATING THE ACQUISITION OF IMMOVABLE PROPERTY BY ALIENS.

Governor.

BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Immovable Property Acquisition (Aliens) Amendment Law, 1936, and shall be read as one with the Immovable Property Acquisition (Aliens) Law, 1936, (hereinafter called the "Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Immovable Property Acquisition (Aliens) Laws, 1936.

Short title.

2. Sub-section (3) of section 4 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following sub-section substituted therefor :—

"(3) Any regulations made under this section may enable the Governor to exempt, in such manner as the regulations may prescribe, any alien or class of aliens from the operation of such regulations and of the proviso to section 5."

This Law came into operation on 25th September, 1936.
