BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Recovery of Compensation for Injury to Property (Amendment) Law, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Recovery of Compensation for Injury to Property Laws, 1930 to 1935, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Recovery of Compensation for Injury to Property Laws, 1930 to 1937.

1. This Law may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration (Amendment) Law, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Births and Deaths Registration Laws, 1895 and 1928, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration Laws, 1895 to 1937.

2. Section 21 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "the sum of 3c.p. in respect of each entry of a birth and 4½c.p. in respect of each entry of a death" and by the substitution therefor of the words "the sum of four and a half piastres in respect of each entry of a birth or of a death".
