A LAW TO AMEND THE LAW REGULATING THE EMPLOYMENT OF WOMEN DURING THE NIGHT.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Employment of Women (during the Night) Amendment Law, 1938, and shall be read as one with the Employment of Women (during the Night) Laws, 1932, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Employment of Women (during the Night) Laws, 1932 to 1938.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion in the definition of the word "night" of the following proviso :—

Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Law.

" Provided that, where there are exceptional circumstances affecting the workers employed in a particular industry or area, the Governor may order that in the case of any women employed in that industry or area, the interval between eleven o'clock in the evening and six o'clock in the morning may be substituted for the interval between ten o'clock in the evening and five o'clock in the morning."

3. The Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after section 4 of the following section :—

Insertion of new section in the Principal Law.

" Saving.

5. The provisions of this Law shall not apply to women holding responsible positions of management who are not ordinarily engaged in manual work."
