A LAW TO AMEND THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES)
LAWS, 1936 AND 1937.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Health (Villages) Amendment Law, 1938, and shall be read as one with the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 and 1937, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1938.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

2. The provisions of this Law shall apply to the villages set out in the Schedule to this Law :

Provided that the Governor in Council may by Order to be published in the *Gazette* vary or amend the said Schedule and may by such Order—

(a) add to the said Schedule any village not being a Summer Resort within the meaning of the Summer Resorts (Development) Law, 1938, or a Municipal Corporation within the meaning of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1938, or part of such a Municipal Corporation ;

(b) delete from the said Schedule any village and, subject to the provisions of section 52 of the Summer Resorts (Development) Law, 1938, give directions with regard to the procedure consequent upon such Order and for the disposal of any moneys in the Village Health Fund of such village at the date of such Order."
