PROPERTY (RESTRICTION AND POSTPONEMENT

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) (Continuance) Law, 1938. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained—

(a) in section 10 of the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) Laws, 1935 and 1938, and
