**THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS**

**No. 9 OF 1939.**

A LAW TO REGULARIZE CERTAIN PAYMENTS MADE IN THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDED ON THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1938.

*Officer Administering the Government.*

WHEREAS the Appropriation Law, 1938, made certain provision for defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1938, and whereas it is necessary to make certain additional provision for the public service for the said period. 3 of 1938.

BE it therefore enacted by the His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Law, 1939. Short title.

2. The sums of money set forth in the Schedule to this Law, having been expended in respect of the establishments or services therein mentioned beyond the amounts granted for those services for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1938, by the Appropriation Law, 1938, such sums are hereby declared to have been duly laid out and expended in defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for those twelve months and are hereby approved allowed and granted in addition to the sums mentioned for those establishments and services in the said Law. Appropriation of £16,805 for the twelve months ended the 31st December, 1938. 3 of 1938.
