**THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS**

A LAW TO AMEND THE CIVIL PROCEDURE  
LAWS, 1885 TO 1934.

*Officer Administering the Government.*

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Civil Procedure (Amendment) Law, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Civil Procedure Laws, 1885 to 1934, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Civil Procedure Laws, 1885 to 1939.

2. Section 14 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

Repeal of section 14 of Law 10 of 1885 and substitution of new section.

"What goods of the debtor are not liable to execution.

14. The following goods shall not be liable to be taken in execution :—

(a) The necessary wearing apparel of the debtor and his family, the necessary box or wardrobe for preserving the same and the necessary beds and bedding of the debtor and his family ;

(b) The necessary baking and cooking utensils of the debtor and his family ;
