A LAW TO AMEND THE BANKING BUSINESS (TEMPORARY
RESTRICTIONS) LAW, 1939.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Banking Business (Temporary Restrictions) Amendment Law, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Banking Business (Temporary Restrictions) Law, 1939, (hereinafter called “the Principal Law”), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Banking Business (Temporary Restrictions) Laws, 1939. Short title.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the addition at the end of sub-section (3) thereof of the following words:— Amendment
of section 3
of the
Principal
Law.
“ or licensed under this Law ”.

3. Section 4 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (d) thereof and by the substitution therefor of the following paragraphs:— Amendment
of section 4
of the
Principal
Law.

“(d) in granting a licence under this section the Controller may attach thereto such conditions, to be observed by the licensee, as he may deem fit ;
