A LAW TO CONTINUE IN OPERATION THE IMMOVABLE
PROPERTY (RESTRICTION AND POSTPONEMENT
OF SALES) LAWS, 1935 TO (No. 2) 1939.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) (Continuance) Law, 1939. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything in section 10 of the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) Laws, 1935 to (No. 2) 1939, or in any other Law contained, the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) Laws, 1935 to (No. 2) 1939, shall continue in force until the 31st day of December, 1940. Continuance of the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) Laws, 1935 to (No. 2) 1939.

3. This Law shall come into operation as from the 1st day of January, 1940. Date of coming into operation.
