**A LAW TO AMEND THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY
LAW, 1939.**

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Amendment) Law, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Trading with the Enemy Law, 1939, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Law”), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 and 1940.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the addition at the end of the definition of “enemy territory” of the following:—

“, and also any area which the Governor may by order direct to be treated for the purpose of this Law as enemy territory”.
