A LAW TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1940.

Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1940.
