BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Civil Defence Short title.

“civil defence organization” means any organization established for civil defence purposes which is declared by the Governor to be a civil defence organization for the purposes of this Law;

“civil defence volunteer”, in relation to an injury, means a person certified by the Officer to have been a member of a civil defence organization at the time the injury was sustained;

“Officer” means the person appointed by the Governor to be in charge of any civil defence organization;
