A LAW TO AMEND THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY TAX
LAWS, 1932 TO 1934.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Immovable Property Tax (Amendment) Law, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Immovable Property Tax Laws, 1932 to 1934, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Law”), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Immovable Property Tax Laws, 1932 to 1942.

2. Section 5A of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion from the twelfth line thereof of the word “one” and the substitution therefor of the word “four”.
