A LAW FURTHER TO AMEND THE CHARITIES LAWS, 1925
TO 1934.C. C. WOOLLEY,

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Charities (Amendment) Law, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Charities Laws, 1925 to 1934, (hereinafter referred to as “ the principal Law ”), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Charities Laws, 1925 to 1943.

2. Section 12 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

“ Enrolment
of deeds, etc.

12.—(1) Every deed, will or other instrument creating a charity shall be enrolled in the office of the Registrar of the Supreme Court.

(2) Such enrolment shall be effected by the depositing with the Registrar of the Supreme Court of the deed, will or other instrument :

Provided that where a deed, will or other instrument has been executed out of the Colony a copy thereof duly certified as in sub-section (3) hereof may be deposited instead of the original.

(3) A copy of a deed, will or other instrument executed out of the Colony shall be deemed to be duly certified if certified as a true copy thereof by a British Consular Authority or by a notary public.

(4) A deed, will or other instrument creating a charity may be certified in the Colony by a Registrar of a District Court or by a Certifying Officer appointed under the provisions of the Certifying Officers Law, 1888.

(5) A copy certified by the Registrar of the Supreme Court to be a true copy of a deed, will or other instrument deposited in his office or to be a true copy of any copy of a deed, will or other instrument executed out of the Colony deposited in his office shall be received as evidence of the contents and enrolment thereof.”
