

- (ii) notify in writing his new address to persons who have consulted him professionally ;
- (iii) notify his new address by notice published in any newspaper ;
- (c) he may, within one month from the date of his registration under the provisions of this Law, notify his establishment in the Colony, as a medical practitioner, by notice published in any newspaper ;
- (d) he may, within one month from the date of the registration of a nursing home under the provisions of the Registration of Nursing Homes Law, 1933, notify the establishment of such nursing home, by notice published in any newspaper ;

Provided further that every notice which a medical practitioner may publish in any newspaper under the provisions of this sub-section shall be in such form and shall contain such particulars as the Director may in each case approve and shall not be published in more than three issues of any such newspaper."

A LAW TO AMEND THE HOTELS LAWS, 1935 AND 1938.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Hotels (Amendment) Law, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Hotels Laws, 1935 and 1938, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law") and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Hotels Laws, 1935 to 1943.
