THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS
No. 24 OF 1944.

A LAW TO AMEND THE STAMP LAWS, 1923 TO 1944.

[6th July, 1944.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Stamp (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Stamp Laws, 1923 to 1944, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Law”), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Stamp Laws, 1923 to (No. 2) 1944.

2. The Schedule to the principal Law is hereby amended as follows :—

(i) by the insertion after paragraph (3) of item 15 thereof (relating to policies of insurance) of the following paragraph :—

“ (4) Workmen’s Compensation.. £0 0 4½ ”

(ii) by the deletion of paragraph (b) of item 19 thereof (relating to undertakings to shipping agents for the delivery of goods pending arrival of shipping documents) and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph :—

“ (b) where the sum stipulated
exceeds £50 £0 1 0 ”
