A LAW TO AMEND THE CAROB WEIGHING AND SHIPPING
PLACE IMPROVEMENT LAWS, 1914 TO 1944.C. C. WOOLLEY,
Governor.

[19th September, 1944.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Carob Weighing and Shipping Place Improvement (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Carob Weighing and Shipping Place Improvement Laws, 1914 to 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Carob Weighing and Shipping Place Improvement Laws, 1914 to (No. 2) 1944.
