Officer Administering the Government.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Civil Procedure (Amendment) Law, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Civil Procedure Laws, 1885 to 1939, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Civil Procedure Laws, 1885 to 1944.

2. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after section 9 of the following section:—

"Judgment
debts to
carry interest
at 4 per
centum.

9A. Every judgment debt shall carry interest at the rate of four per centum per annum from the date on which the judgment is pronounced until the same shall be satisfied and such interest may be levied under a writ of execution on such judgment:

Provided that nothing in this section contained shall apply to any judgment pronounced before the 16th day of November, 1944, and every such judgment shall carry such interest as may be specified therein and in accordance with the terms thereof:

Provided also that where any judgment relates to a debt carrying interest, no interest shall be paid under the provisions of this section except on the principal debt or any balance thereof remaining due and unpaid."
