A LAW TO AMEND THE MATRIMONIAL CAUSES
(WAR MARRIAGES) LAW, 1945.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Matrimonial Causes (War Marriages) Amendment Law, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Matrimonial Causes (War Marriages) Law, 1945, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Law”), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Matrimonial Causes (War Marriages) Laws, 1945. 2. The proviso to sub-section (2) of section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after the word “residence” of the words “, and for the purposes of this proviso the whole of the United States of America, the whole of India and the whole of any British possession outside India shall each be treated as one country”.
