Officer Administering the Government.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering
the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the
Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Amendment Law, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Law, 1946, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Laws, 1946 and 1947. Short title.

2. Sub-section (3) of section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "the Attorney-General" (lines 2 and 3) and the substitution therefor of the words "a Law Officer". Amendment

3. Section 4 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figure "1947" (line 3) and the substitution therefor of the figure "1948". Amendment
