A LAW TO AMEND THE TOBACCO LAWS, 1932 TO 1946.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Tobacco (Amendment) Law, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1946, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Law”), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1948.

2. Section 38 of the principal Law (as set out in Law 23 of 1945) is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

“Consump-
tion duty.

38. There shall be paid, in the manner hereinafter provided, upon every coke of manufactured tobacco, consumption duty at the rate of three pounds, two shillings and eight piastres.”
