A LAW TO ENABLE THE SALE OF THE GOVERNMENT
COTTON SPINNING FACTORY.

WHEREAS during the last war certain lands were acquired under the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, in connection with the erection by the Government of a Cotton Spinning Factory in the town of Nicosia;

And whereas it is considered as no longer necessary for Government to operate a Cotton Spinning Factory;

BE it, therefore, enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Government Cotton Spinning Factory (Disposal) Law, 1950. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, or in any other Law, Government shall have power to sell, without any restriction whatsoever, the Government Cotton Spinning Factory as aforesaid, including any lands acquired in connection therewith under the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, and no person shall have any right of pre-emption over any lands so acquired in connection with such factory. Power to sell the Government Cotton Spinning Factory.
