A LAW TO AMEND THE INFANTS' ESTATES ADMINISTRATION

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Infants' Estates Administration (Amendment) Law, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Infants' Estates Administration Law, 1894 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Infants' Estates Administration Laws, 1894 and 1951.

2. Section 47 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

"Adminis-
tration of
estates of
deceased
moslems.

47. The administration of the estates of deceased moslems whose heirs or any of them are under disability, or absent from Cyprus, shall be carried out by the Turkish Family Courts in accordance with the provisions of this Law and, for this purpose—

(a) a judge of a Turkish Family Court shall have all the powers possessed by a Court under this Law with regard to non-moslem estates ;

(b) all powers and duties vested in a Registrar of a District Court under this Law shall vest in such officer of the Turkish Family Court as the judge of such court may direct."

3. This Law shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Governor by notice in the *Gazette*.
