A LAW TO AMEND THE PRESS LAW, 1947.

Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Press (Amendment) Law, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Press Law, 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Press Laws, 1947 and 1951.
