THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 15 OF 1952.

A LAW TO AMEND THE TRADE UNIONS LAW.

CAP. 172

Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Trade Unions (Amendment) Law, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Trade Unions Law (hereinafter called "the principal Law").

Short title.

Cap. 172.

2. Section 22 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

Repeal of section 22 and substitution of new section.

"Age limit for membership.

22.—(1) No person under the age of eighteen shall be a member of a trade union.

(2) No member of a trade union under the age of twenty-one shall be a member of the committee of management of the trade union or the committee of any branch thereof."
