A LAW TO AMEND THE MERCHANT SHIPPING (SAFETY
REGULATION AND SEAMEN) LAW, 1952.A. B. WRIGHT,]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Safety Regulation and Seamen) (Amendment) Law, 1953, and shall be read as one with the Merchant Shipping (Safety Regulation and Seamen) Law, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. Sub-section (1) of section 12 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following sub-section substituted therefor :—

Schedule.

"(1) The enactments mentioned in the first column of the Schedule are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the second column of the said Schedule."

3. The Schedule to the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted therefor :—
