A LAW TO AMEND THE PRIVATE HOSPITALS (CONTROL) LAW, 1952. 27 of 1952.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Private Hospitals (Control) (Amendment) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Private Hospitals (Control) Law, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law") and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Private Hospitals (Control) Laws, 1952 and 1954.

Short title.

2. Section 6 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following proviso (the full stop at the end thereof being substituted by a colon) :—

Amendment of section 6 of the principal Law.

"Provided that nothing in this Law shall be deemed to authorize the Director to inspect any medical record relating to any patient in a private hospital."
