A LAW TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS TARIFF LAWS, 1954 AND 1955.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Amendment) Law, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Customs Tariff Laws, 1954 and 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Customs Tariff Laws, 1954 to 1956.

Amendment of the First Schedule to the principal Law.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein, in its proper alphabetical place, of the word "Burma".

Amendment of Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal Law.

3. Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal Law (under the heading "Goods Liable to Customs Duty") is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the alterations and substitutions specified in the second column of Part I of the First Schedule to this Law, of the items of Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal Law, specified in the first column of Part I of the First Schedule to this Law ;

(b) by the insertion in Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal Law, in their proper numerical order, of the new items specified in Part II of the First Schedule to this Law.

First Schedule.

Amendment of Part II of the Second Schedule to the principal Law.

4. Part II of the Second Schedule to the principal Law (under the heading "Unclassified Exempted Goods, Not Otherwise Specified") is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the deletions, alterations and substitutions specified in the second column of Part I of the Second Schedule to this Law, of the items of Part II of the Second Schedule to the principal Law, specified in the first column of Part I of the Second Schedule to this Law ;

(b) by the insertion in Part II of the Second Schedule to the principal Law, in their proper numerical order, of the new items specified in Part II of the Second Schedule to this Law.

PART I.

DELETIONS, ALTERATIONS AND SUBSTITUTIONS.

Items	Extent of Amendment.
14E.	For item 14E the following shall be substituted :— “ 14E. Baggage :— (1) <i>Intending residents</i> (including persons born in the Colony who are resuming permanent residence after a prolonged period of absence): The <i>bona fide</i> baggage of a person arriving in the Colony for the purpose of taking up residence in the Colony, the property of and accompanied by or arriving within six months before or after the arrival of such person or within such further period as the Comptroller may allow.
